Website, Technology, Privacy DRAFT

The website received a bit over double the unique visitors in October compared to the previous two months. Most of that increase coming from bookmarks and email links (probably our newsletter). The most used operating system is Windows and the most used web browser (by a long way) is Google Chrome.

On the website, we had a new entry submitted in the trades and services directory, and I would like Regine to look at it before publishing it.

This newsletter mailing list has 628 addresses with 40% of them opening the email and 4-6% clicking on a link inside the newsletter. These stats will probably be under reporting this because I suspect plenty of our subscribers have privacy protection on their devices (yes!) and that would prevent Mailchimp from collecting the information.

In other news, I am very pleased to report that our initial meetup last Saturday for the Gympie Digital Privacy User Group (GDPUG) at Veteran Hall went quite well and I think that most of the 15 attendees enjoyed and learned good stuff.
